

The All Inclusive Ten Commandments

7. **Promote the truth.** Do not lie for personal gain. Do not bear false witness against your neighbor.
8. **Respect all living things.** Do not be cruel to animals or other living things.
9. **Do those actions that aid** the greater number of life and spiritual beings of all universes to survive.
10. **Set up an effective government** to encourage, reward, and if needed police the preceding.
